

Dr. Akbar Dastjerdi is a veterinary graduate from Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Tehran. He further accomplished an MSc in Veterinary Microbiology and a PhD in Veterinary Virology from the Royal Veterinary College (RVC), University of London. Akbar had spent several years researching bone and cartilage development at the RVC and King's College, London before embarking on his new career. He is currently the head of Mammalian Virus Investigation Unit at the Animal and Plant Health Agency. He is also OIE disease expert for the Infectious Bovine Rhinotracheitis (IBR) and a member of the herpesvirus study group of the International Committee on Taxonomy of Viruses (ICTV). His interests include herpesviruses research and emerging and novel viral disease investigations. He is the author of more than 40 scientific papers in peer-reviewed journals.
