Professor Javier Garau, MD, PhD, graduated at the Universidad Complutense, Madrid, Spain and completed his Medical Residence and Infectious Diseases Fellowship at the University of Chicago, USA. Associate Professor of Medicine at the University of Barcelona 19880-2010, and Head of the Department of Medicine at Hospital Universitari Mutua de Terrassa, Barcelona (1984-2010).

Professor Garau is a member of many medical committees and professional societies, and an editorial board member of several peer-reviewed journals. He served as President of *La Sociedad Española de Enfermedades Infecciosas y Microbiología Clínica* (1990-1992) and Vice-President of the *Spanish Society of Chemotherapy* (1988-1990). He is also a diplomat of the *American Board of Internal Medicine* and the *American Board of Infectious Diseases*.

Professor Garau has served as the Education Officer and Secretary General for the *European Society of Clinical Microbiology and Infectious Diseases (ESCMID)* (2005-2009), and as the President of ESCMID up until May 2010.

Professor Garau has authored over 220 peer-reviewed publications in the fields of clinical microbiology and infectious diseases, and his research interests include community-acquired bacterial infections, antibiotic resistance and new antimicrobials.
